Performing Arts:

Company	Description	Possible Internship Position
	<p>The Nephesh Theatre was founded in 1978 by Howard Rypp as artistic director and Gabriel Emanuel as dramaturge. It was the only professional Jewish theatre operating in Canada at that time. It's initial play, "Children of Night," about Jewish educator Jansuz Korczak, had three different productions presented throughout Canada and took part in the first international Festival of Jewish Theatre, in New York, 1980.</p>	<p>Position Title: Stage Management Intern</p> <p>Internship Description: The intern will attend rehearsals of productions, travel with shows, and stage manage select productions. They will write rehearsal notes, including blocking and props tracking. They will travel with several of the children productions and will be responsible for helping the actors with whatever is needed, as well as doing miscellaneous tasks such as ironing and helping set props for the show.</p> <p>Requirements: A passion for theatre is a must. Experience with stage management is necessary.</p>
	<p>The Suzanne Dellal Centre for Dance and Theatre is the home of dance in Israel and the premier presenter of Israeli and international contemporary dance companies. The mission of the Suzanne Dellal Centre is to cultivate, support and promote the art of contemporary dance in Israel. The Centre pursues this mission by offering a variety of events, festivals, and workshops across artistic disciplines, ensuring that dance stays in close relationship with all art forms. The Centre hosts courses for dancers and choreographers, as well as lectures by renowned artists.</p>	<p>Position Title: Foreign Relations Intern</p> <p>Internship Description: The intern will be in charge of bringing companies from around the world to perform at the centre. The intern will also work on the logistics for bringing the centre's company to festivals around the world.</p> <p>Requirements: Looking for someone who is highly organized, who pays attention to detail, and has a passion for the performing arts.</p>
	<p>The Cameri Theatre, Tel Aviv municipal theatre, was founded in 1944. It is considered the largest and most prolific theatre in Israel. Each year the Cameri stages up to twelve new productions, together with twenty productions from previous seasons. The theatre is located in the center of Tel Aviv. All the productions run there in its 5 auditoriums. The Cameri also has a touring company that brings its productions to the periphery, throughout Israel.</p>	<p>Position Title: Hair and Make-up artist</p> <p>Internship Description: You will be the creative assistant to the wigs and make-up manager, helping out by creating, washing and setting wigs, preparing the make-up boxes for each actor, attending dress rehearsals and shadowing the hair and make-up artists as they prepare the actors for show time.</p> <p>Requirements: Previous experience working with hair and makeup.</p>

	<p>Keith Glassman shoots primarily for advertisements, catalogs, magazines, packaging and corporate brochures. He is known for his keen sense of composition and lighting, and for his eye for design, which he developed while growing up around the graphic design industry. Keith maintains a studio in Tel-Aviv, Israel. His clients include major brands, advertising firms & graphic design studios.</p>	<p>Position Title: Assistant to the Photographer Internship Description: The intern will assist the photographer with tasks such as photo retouching, setting up/running/taking down photo shoots, and any other tasks with which the photographer needs help. Requirements: Prior education/experience in photography, photo retouching, Photoshop and Lightroom are very useful in this position.</p>
	<p>The Sommer Contemporary Art Gallery is committed to promoting Israeli artists in the international art scene, as well as representing and exhibiting leading international artists in Israel and abroad. The gallery is distinguished by the deep relationships it develops with artists, from emerging and mid-career to established, by regularly collaborating with museums, biennials and publishing houses, and creating meaningful exhibitions and publications. The gallery also aims to bring artistic exchange, experimentation and discussion to the forefront. In the gallery's project room, "S2", young curators receive an opportunity to curate small scale exhibitions of emerging artists.</p>	<p>Position Title: Gallery Intern Internship Description: The gallery intern is the right hand of the gallery manager. The intern is responsible for reorganizing and helping install a better art inventory program, both for the artwork that is hanging in the gallery as well as what is in storage. Other projects include helping install artwork in exhibits, overseeing food and drinks at exhibit opening nights. Requirements: BA in Art History is recommended but not required. Interest in art and background in gallery curation is helpful.</p>
	<p>The Noga Gallery of Contemporary Art was established in 1994, designed for ground-breaking artists working across media. The gallery maintains an ambitious program of exhibitions by Israeli and international artists, introducing and supporting artists at earlier stages in their career, who work in the media of performance, painting, photography, film, video art and installation.</p>	<p>Position Title: Marketing Intern Internship Description: Intern will manage all social networks, including Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and LinkedIn. They will also contact contemporary art blogs and journals in Israel and abroad, as well as help set up exhibitions and attend openings. Requirements: Bachelor's degree in art, art history, communications, or marketing is desired. Passion for arts is required.</p>

The lab is working for customers, usually companies, who send orders asking to test the required quality for materials (textiles). Requirements: Intern must have an interest in fashion. Experience in textile testing is useful.</p>
	<p>FOX is an Israel-based fashion chain specializing in women's, men's, children's, and babies' fashions: FOX, FOX MEN, FOX KIDS, FOX HOME and FOX BABY. Fox was founded in 1942 in pre-state Israel as Trico Fox Ltd. Today, Fox is an international chain with stores in 13 countries. There are more than 200 retail shops in Israel.</p>	<p>Position Title: Fashion and Graphic Design Developer Internship Description: You will work as a womenswear design developer. You will help the department with designs for the upcoming collections. Tasks include trend research, designing, technical drawing and techpacks. Requirements: You must have a portfolio of work to apply for this position.</p>
