Almost all families have a low socio-economic status. They live predominantly in the southern neighborhoods of the city of Tel-Aviv. The school's main objective is to provide these underprivileged students with opportunities to develop their potential.</p>	<p><b>Position Title:</b> English Tutor</p> <p><b>Internship Description:</b> Intern will assist students at the Bialik-Rogozin School by preparing them for their Bagrut Exams. A bagrut is a certificate which attests that a student has successfully passed Israel's high school matriculation examination. Bagrut is a prerequisite for higher education in Israel.</p> <p><b>Requirements:</b> A desire to help underprivileged students, fluency in English. Teaching experience is highly preferred but not required.</p>
