### Job Description

#### **ORGANIZATION BACKGROUND**

Young Judaea is a diverse community that educates and empowers Jewish youth to deeply engage with Israel and to lead positive change for the Jewish People, Israel and the World. For over 115 years, Young Judaea has inspired Jewish youth of diverse backgrounds to become engaged leaders and inspired activists with a deep personal connection to Israel. Young Judaea does this through a robust arc of programs that include junior/regional camps, a national teen camp, year-round regional and national programming, Israel immersive travel experiences, and alumni gatherings. Young Judaea Teens is the movement's teen division, providing Jewish teens with opportunities to build community, develop leadership skills, explore their identities, and create meaningful impact through peer-led programming and engagement.

#### **SUMMARY OF JOB RESPONSIBILITIES**

The National Advisor serves as the primary mentor to the National Mazkirut (National Teen Leadership Board) throughout the academic year and summer, supporting top teen leadership. This role focuses on developing leaders, strengthening national programming, and fostering connections within the Young Judaea movement.

Working closely with the National Mazkirut, the National Advisor provides mentorship, leadership development, and strategic guidance, helping teens turn their vision into impactful programs. The Advisor also acts as a liaison between teen leadership, professional staff, and organizational leaders. This is a year-round role consisting of an academic-year advisor position and a summer staff position at Tel Yehudah, each with separate compensation.

#### **CORE JOB RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Serve as the primary advisor and mentor to the National Mazkirut
- Facilitate weekly meetings with the National Mazkirut
- Conduct monthly one-on-one meetings with each Mazkirut member
- Guide and support the planning, execution, and leadership of National Convention and other national programs
- Partner with National Mazkirut members to mentor and support Regional Mazkirut
- Collaborate on the development and implementation of leadership training initiatives
- Serve as a liaison between the National Mazkirut and Young Judaea leadership
- Build strong, trusting relationships with teen leaders across the movement
- Support and mobilize the National Mazkirut in response to current events and emerging community needs
- Oversee National Mazkirut engagement and programming during TY



- Strengthen connections between regions, national leadership, and the broader Young Judaea movement

### **ADDITIONAL JOB RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Attend weekly meetings with the National Mazkirut
- Hold monthly one-on-one meetings with Mazkirut members
- Participate in monthly advisor meetings
- Support and participate in national programming and leadership initiatives throughout the year
- Collaborate with professional staff and volunteer leadership to advance movement-wide goals
- Serve on summer staff during Tel Yehudah's camp sessions

- Strong leadership development, facilitation, and interpersonal skills
- Experience in program planning, event management, or youth development
- Ability to work independently in a remote environment

- Bachelor's degree preferred
- Commitment to Young Judaea's mission and values

### **POSITION DETAILS**

- Approximately 40 hours per month during the academic year
- Primarily remote during the academic year, with regular virtual meetings and periodic in-person gatherings
- Work is primarily conducted during afternoons, evenings, and weekends to align with teen schedules
- Attendance required at three annual in-person weekends:
  - MLT Weekend (late August–early September)
  - National Convention (MLK Weekend)
  - Altneu Weekend (May)
- Summer TY role is full-time in person

### **COMPENSATION**

- \$10,000 annual stipend for the academic year National Advisor role
- Additional compensation for required full-time summer employment at Tel Yehudah
- Travel and accommodations are provided for attending conventions
